

## 90<sup>th</sup> Anniversary



Holy Sacraments in our midst. Martin Luther's hymn comes to mind: "If God had not been on our side And had not come to aid us. The foes with all their pow'r and pride Would surely have dismayed us...."

In 1926/1927 Dr. E.L. Hennig, Mrs. Wagner, Mrs. Miller and Mrs. Hall met in Dr. Hennig's office to discuss the formation of a Lutheran church in Herrin, IL. On May 22, 1927, Trinity **Evangelical Lutheran Congregation U.A.C.** (Unaltered Augsburg Confession) held its **first service** at 101 West Tyler Street, Herrin II. The Rev. Walter H. Schmid of Mt. Vernon.

IL served as her first pastor. The Rev. Charles Louis Rutz who served St. Paul Lutheran Church of West Frankfort preached the evening service. Fortyfive people attended the morning service and 38 attended the evening service.

What we are celebrating this month of May includes something much more frail than wood and stone. Over 90 years God has worked through a host of sinful human beings to proclaim the gospel message of the forgiveness of sins through faith in Jesus Christ alone. That message of forgiveness is a stumbling block to some and foolishness to others, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God! Without God creating and maintaining a lively faith we would have

served our interests and been overcome by the sinful foe inside of each of us.

The Lord in his mercy has provided for us through the work of the pastoral office—the fruits of Christ's death and resurrection. We have received faith and the fruits of faith. The Lord has called us back from our sin and worked repentance. He has comforted us with forgiveness and assured us of His grace. The Lord has received our children in Holy Baptism and nourished us with His Body and Blood. The Lord has allowed us to be a light shining on a hill. That is what we celebrate this month.

And finally, knowing that "the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God..." (1 Cor 2:14), we pray that the Lord will



continue to convert and maintain believers so that the precious treasure of His Word is preserved among us. We ask that He would provide godly pastors, who would be faithful stewards of God's mysteries, feeding the flock with the pure Gospel. And we ask that He would give to this congregation hearing ears, and open and willing hearts to listen to the Word with God-given joy.
