Seminary

This past week I attended the annual synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Diocese of North America. In the past we have combined this business meeting with a colloquium, in which Eldona pastors and others deliver theological papers. This year's gathering took a different format. Back in January we had our colloquium, knowing that our June gathering would include the graduation of our first seminarian, Josiah Scheck, from St. Ignatius Seminary.

Three years ago, St. Ignatius opened her doors. Though I say, "opened her doors," I mean that metaphorically. We don't actually have a seminary campus or even a specific building that is exclusively the location for the seminary. Early on our diocese knew that we were going to need to train men as pastors to serve the missions that were being planted and to replace pastors who retire. Not wanting to saddle men with large



amounts of debt, we set out to provide a highquality education, but without the high cost of building maintenance and infrastructure.

Almost all of the teaching occurs at Salem Lutheran Church in Malone, Texas. In addition to Bishop James Heiser's oversight over the pastors of our dioceses, he also serves as the headmaster. In order that Bp. Heiser might accomplish this work, **Deacon Anthony** Oncken is called to assist Bp. Heiser with the pastoral duties at Salem Lutheran Church. as well as in the teaching of some of the

seminary classes. Several of the pastors of the diocese also regularly teach courses either in person or by means of two-way video communication over the internet. Over the course of three years—including fall and spring semesters, as well as two- or fourweek intensives in the summer and other times—this instruction has produced a man, who is "able to teach" (1 Tim 3:2).

On Tuesday of our synod, Josiah Scheck presented his thesis, "Faith and Philosophy:



The Principles of a Christian Approach to Non-Christian Literature and Some Examples." Over the course of an hour, he defended his paper before three of the pastors. Later, Mr. Scheck read for us a trial sermon and presented a catechetical outline on a topic for teaching. Although Mr. Scheck has taken courses in preaching, he has not gone on a vicarage, where he would practice preaching and teaching in a congregation. We seek to uphold Augsburg Confession, Article XIV, "It is taught among us that nobody should publicly teach or preach or

administer the sacraments in the church without a regular call."

In the afternoon, Mr. Scheck was also examined by all of the pastors the diocese. In other words, we peppered him with questions for about 2.5 hours. We asked about theological doctrines, dogmatic terminology, practical application and casuistry. He was even asked about the Latin names of the liturgical Sundays in Lent. We needed to determine whether he would "Hold fast the pattern of sound words which you have heard from me, in faith and love which are in Christ Jesus" (2 Timothy 1:13). I am pleased to inform you that Mr. Scheck passed his theological interview with flying colors!

I informed Bp. Heiser that I was extremely impressed with the quality of our first seminarian. Not only were his answers Scriptural and Confessional, but when asked about delivering the truth of God's word to a hypothetical situation, he was confident, instructive and showed a pastoral heart.

On Wednesday evening, Mr. Scheck received a finely crafted certificate (in Latin, of course) confirming his completion of studies in a ceremony following the Divine Service. At the end of that ceremony, he was presented with a Divine call to Christ Lutheran Church in Richmond. MO, which He subsequently accepted. God willing, Pastor-Elect Scheck will be ordained at Christ Lutheran Church in Richmond on Friday, July 27 at 7 PM.

Pr. Chuck Hudson, the present pastor of Christ-Richmond is retiring. The ordination of Pastor-Elect Scheck will bring to a close my twice-a-month Saturday drive to Richmond for services and Bible Study. In April, Pr. Hudson had tests which revealed type 2 cancer in one of his lungs. He is presently undergoing chemotherapy every three weeks. --MDH
