Logic: The Four Causes

"A cause is something that brings about an effect, and every effect has one or more causes."

Formal Cause: what kind of thing it is; the thing's nature or <u>essence</u> (the form of the thing)

Material Cause: what a thing is composed of; the matter

Efficient Cause: who or what made a thing or keeps it in existence; the external agent that brings it into existence or sustains it

Final Cause: the purpose or potential use of a thing; the <u>reason</u> or <u>purpose</u> the agent brings the thing about



"There is a second efficient or working cause for our justification, namely <a href="Christ">Christ</a> in and with His whole work as Mediator.... On this basis we can explain the rationale for saying that <a href="Christ the Mediator">Christ the Mediator</a>, with His work, is the efficient cause of our justification" (p.550).


