1. Writer's Name:
  - a. His apostolic call: In the last three classes I gave a lengthy explanation
  - b. St. Paul return to this same outline to explain the apostolic message (v.11) Compare "Office: Origin and Means" chart.
  - c. "He who raised Him from the dead"
    - i. The Risen Christ commissioned St. Paul Acts 9:5, 22:3
    - ii. Witness of the resurrection Acts 1:21-22
    - iii. Integral to the Gospel/Justification
    - iv. Father raised Jesus Rom 6:4, Mt 16:21
    - v. Christ raised Himself Jn 10:17-18, Jn 2:18-20

### Galatians (NIV)

**1** Paul, an apostle—sent not from men nor by man, but by Jesus Christ and God the Father, who raised him from the dead—<sup>2</sup> and all the brothers with me,

To the churches in Galatia:

<sup>3</sup> Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ,<sup>4</sup> who gave himself for our sins to rescue us from the present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father,<sup>5</sup> to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.<sup>1</sup>

### Galatians (NKJV)

#### *Greeting*

**1** Paul, an apostle (not from men nor through man, but <sup>a</sup>through Jesus Christ and God the Father <sup>b</sup>who raised Him from the dead),<sup>2</sup> and all the brethren who are with me,

To the churches of Galatia:

<sup>3</sup> Grace to you and peace from God the Father and our Lord Jesus Christ,<sup>4</sup> <sup>c</sup>who gave Himself for our sins, that He might deliver us <sup>d</sup>from this present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father,<sup>5</sup> to whom *be* glory forever and ever. Amen.<sup>2</sup>
