may be ascribed to the entire Person








The Second Genus

The Divine Nature imparts and communicates its majesty, glory and attributes to the Human Nature to enhance it.

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But the Human Nature does not impart its attributes to the Divine Nature so as to limit or diminish it.

They are ascribed to both natures conjointly.
