# The Priests and the Servant

In the Old Testament, God directed the Levitical priesthood to offer sacrifices for the people's sins. However, those Old Testament sacrifices did not merit God's reconciliation, "for it is not possible that the blood of bulls and goats could take away sins" (Heb 10:4). These sacrifices were designed "to signify the future sacrifice of Christ" (Ap XXIV 53)! For example, in Psalm 40:6b-8 Christ speaks to the Father saying, "Burnt offering and sin offering You did not require. <sup>7</sup>Then I said, 'Behold, I come; In the scroll of the book it is written of me. 8I delight to do Your will, O my God, And Your law is within my heart.""

Jesus our High
Priest is the One who
did the will of God by
perfectly keeping the
Law. He was the perfect
Lamb of God who
sacrificed Himself when
He took our punishment
and death. Christ's



sacrifice of atonement is the final, once-for-all, sacrifice for sins. The New Testament does not have a priesthood, which corresponds to the Levitical priesthood designated to make sacrifices for the sins of the people. The Levitical priesthood was "a shadow of the good things to come" (Heb 10:4). It was fulfilled by the priesthood of Jesus Christ.

Nevertheless, there is a New Testament priesthood, quite different from the Old Testament priesthood! According to 1 Peter 2:5 and 2:9, all believers in Christ are priests! The sacrifices of the New Testament priests are "acceptable to God through Jesus Christ" (v.5). Their sacrifices are to "proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of

darkness into His marvelous light" (v.9). The life (Rom 12:1) of the believer, who has been saved by Jesus' sacrifice, is "a sacrifice of thanksgiving" (Ps 116:17). "They call upon God, they give thanks to God, they bear afflictions for their confession, they produce good works for the glory of Christ...." (AC XXIV, 32-33).

"Lastly, the statement of Peter also confirms this, 1 Pet. 2, 9: Ye are a royal priesthood. These words pertain to the true Church, which certainly has the right to elect and ordain ministers since it alone has the priesthood" (PPP, 69). The Pastoral Office is gift given to the priesthood. The right of

Continued from Page 1 the royal priesthood is to elect a fellow priest to become a steward of the Word and Sacraments (1 Cor 4:1). This servant of the Word is what we call a pastor or minister.

"This is accomplished by the preaching of the Gospel. For through this the









name of Christ is made known, and the mercy of the Father, promised in Christ, is recognized. The preaching of the Gospel produces faith in those who receive the Gospel" (AC XXIV, 32). Thus, the pastor serves the priests with the Word and Sacrament and the priests show their thankfulness by receiving the forgiveness of sins. "...the reception itself of the Lord's Supper can be praise or thanksgiving" (AC XXIV, 33). Having received the preaching of the Gospel and the Lord's Body and Blood, the priests live sacrificial lives of thanksgiving in their daily vocation.


