7. **Eternal Election** is more than God knowing all things before it happens. It is a cause of man salvation.

“3] 2. For the foreknowledge of God is nothing else than that God knows all things before they happen, ...”

8. “5] 4. The predestination or eternal election of God, however, **extends only over the godly, beloved children of God**, being a cause of their salvation, which He also provides, as well as disposes what belongs thereto:”

9-10. It is a Gospel teaching designed to comfort and console the believer.

“13] ... **the glorious consolation** which we have in this salutary doctrine, namely, that we know [assuredly] that out of pure grace, without any merit of our own, we have been elected in Christ to eternal life, and that no one can pluck us out of His hand; as He has not only promised this gracious election with mere words, but has also certified it with an oath and sealed it with the holy Sacraments, which we can [ought to] call to mind in our most severe temptations, and take comfort in them, and therewith quench the fiery darts of the devil.”
