

Three uses of the law

1. Curb - restraint on heathen and outward discipline
2. Mirror - knowledge of sin
3. Rule - a guide to regulate the Christian life of thanksgiving

¶2 Although Christians are exempt from curse and coercion

Nevertheless They are not without the law


The Law - shows the will of God
