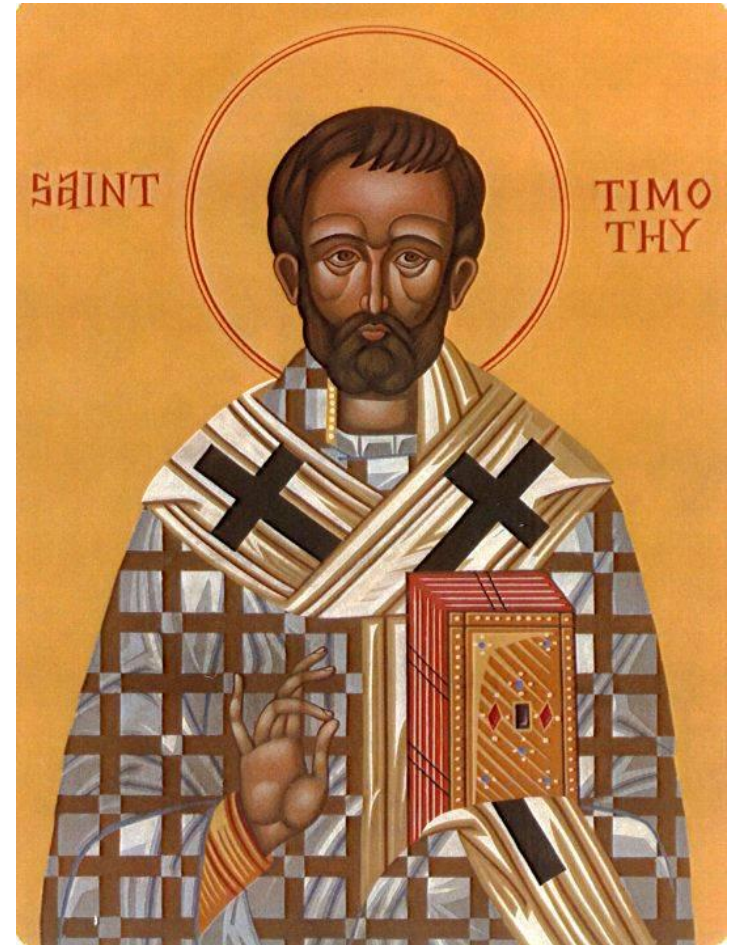

St. Timothy Psalms



Psalm 89

*The law of God is in his heart, and his go-ing shall not slide:
For the Lord makes his way acceptable un-to Him-self.*

- 1 I will sing of the mercies of the Lord for-ev-er;
With my mouth will I make known Your faithfulness
to all gen-er-a-tions.
- 2 For I have said, “Mercy shall be built up for-ev-er;
Your faithfulness You shall establish in the ver-y
heav-ens.”
- 3 “I have made a covenant with My cho-sen,
I have sworn to My ser-vant Da-vid:
- 4 ‘Your seed I will estab-lish for-ev-er,
And build up your throne to all gen-er-a-tions.’ ”
- 5 And the heavens will praise Your won-ders, O Lord;
Your faithfulness also in the as-sem-bly of the saints.
- 6 For who in the heavens can be com-pared to the Lord?
Who among the sons of the mighty can be lik-ened to
the Lord?
- 7 God is greatly to be feared in the as-sem-bly of the saints,
And to be held in reverence by all those a-round Him.
- 8 O Lord God of hosts, Who is mighty like You, O Lord?
Your faithfulness al-so sur-rounds You.
- 9 You rule the rag-ing of the sea;
When its waves rise, You still them.
- 10 You have broken Rahab in pieces, as one who is slain;
You have scattered Your enemies with Your mighty
arm.

- 11 The heavens are Yours, the earth al-so is Yours:
The world and all its fullness, You have founded
them.
 - 12 The north and the south, You have cre-ated them;
Tabor and Hermon re-joice in Your name.
 - 13 You have a mighty arm;
Strong is Your hand, and high is Your right hand.
 - 14 Righteousness and justice are the foun-da-tion of Your
throne;
Mercy and truth go be-fore Your face.
 - 15 Blessed are the people who know the joyful sound!
They walk, O Lord, in the light of Your counte-nance.
 - 16 In Your name they re-joice all day long,
And in Your righteousness they are ex-alt-ed.
 - 17 For You are the glo-ry of their strength,
And in Your favor our horn is ex-alt-ed.
 - 18 For our shield be-longs to the Lord,
And our king to the Holy One of Isra-el.
- Glory be to the Fa-ther and to the Son,
And to the Ho-ly Spir-it.**
- As it was in the be-gin-ning,
Is now, and will be for-ev-er. A-men.**
- Repeat antiphon*



*I have declared Your righteousness and Your sal-va-tion:
I have not kept back Your loving mer-cy and Your truth.*

- 19 Then You spoke in a vision to Your holy one,
And said: “I have given help to one who is mighty; I
have exalted one chosen from the peo-ple.
20 I have found My ser-vant Da-vid;
With My holy oil I have a-nointed him,
21 With whom My hand shall be es-tab-lished;
Also My arm shall strengthen him.
22 The enemy shall not out-wit him,
Nor the son of wicked-ness af-lict him.
23 I will beat down his foes be-fore his face,
And plague those who hate him.
24 “But My faithfulness and My mercy shall be with him,
And in My name his horn shall be ex-alt-ed.
25 Also I will set his hand o-ver the sea,
And his right hand o-ver the riv-ers,
26 He shall cry to Me, ‘You are my Fa-ther,
My God, and the rock of my sal-va-tion.’
27 Also I will make him My first-born,
The highest of the kings of the earth.
28 My mercy I will keep for him for-ev-er,
And My covenant shall stand firm with him.
29 His seed also I will make to en-dure for-ev-er,
And his throne as the days of heav-en.
30 “If his sons for-sake My law
And do not walk in My judg-ments,
31 If they break My stat-utes
And do not keep My com-mand-ments,

- 32 Then I will punish their trans-gres-sion with the rod,
And their in-i-qui-ty with stripes.
33 Nevertheless My lovingkindness I will not utterly take
from him,
Nor allow My faith-ful-ness to fail.
34 My covenant I will not break,
Nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips.
35 Once I have sworn by My holi-ness;
I will not lie to Da-vid:
36 His seed shall en-dure for-ev-er,
And his throne as the sun be-fore Me;
37 It shall be established for-ev-er like the moon,
Even like the faithful wit-ness in the sky.”

- 41 All who pass by the way plunder him;
He is a reproach to his neigh-bors.
- 42 You have exalted the right hand of his ad-ver-sar-ies;
You have made all his en-e-mies re-joice.
- 43 You have also turned back the edge of his sword,
And have not sustained him in the bat-tle.
- 44 You have made his glory cease,
And cast his throne down to the ground.
- 45 The days of his youth You have short-ened;
You have cov-ered him with shame.
- 46 How long, Lord? Will You hide Your-self for-ev-er?
Will Your wrath burn like fire?
- 47 Remember how short my time is;
For what futility have You created all the chil-dren of
men?
- 48 What man can live and not see death?
Can he deliver his life from the pow-er of the grave?
- 49 Lord, where are Your former lov-ing-kindness-es,
Which You swore to Da-vid in Your truth?
- 50 Remember, Lord, the reproach of Your ser-vants—
How I bear in my bosom the reproach of all the man-y
peo-ples,
- 51 With which Your enemies have re-proached, O Lord,
With which they have reproached the footsteps
of Your a-noint-ed.
- 52 Blessed be the Lord for-ev-er-more!
