

St. Timothy Psalms



Psalm 89

The law of God is in his heart, and his <u>go-ing</u> shall not <u>slide</u>: For the Lord makes his way acceptable <u>un-to</u> Him-<u>self</u>.

- 1 I will sing of the mercies of the <u>Lord for-ev-er</u>; With my mouth will I make known Your faithfulness to all <u>gen-er-a-tions</u>.
- 2 For I have said, "Mercy shall be built <u>up for-ev-er;</u> Your faithfulness You shall establish in the <u>ver-y</u> heav-<u>ens.</u>"
- 3 "I have made a covenant with My cho-sen, I have sworn to My ser-vant Da-vid:
- 4 'Your seed I will estab-<u>lish for-ev-er</u>,
 And build up your throne to all <u>gen-er-a-tions</u>.' "
- 5 And the heavens will praise Your <u>won-ders</u>, O <u>Lord</u>; Your faithfulness also in the as-<u>sem-bly</u> of the <u>saints</u>.
- 6 For who in the heavens can be com-<u>pared to</u> the <u>Lord</u>? Who among the sons of the mighty can be <u>lik-ened</u> to the <u>Lord</u>?
- 7 God is greatly to be feared in the as-<u>sem-bly</u> of the <u>saints</u>, And to be held in reverence by all <u>those a-round Him</u>.
- 8 O Lord God of hosts, Who is mighty <u>like You</u>, O <u>Lord?</u> Your faithfulness al-so sur-rounds You.
- 9 You rule the <u>rag-ing</u> of the <u>sea;</u> When its waves <u>rise</u>, <u>You</u> still <u>them</u>.
- 10 You have broken Rahab in pieces, as <u>one who</u> is <u>slain</u>; You have scattered Your enemies <u>with Your</u> mighty arm.



- 11 The heavens are Yours, the earth <u>al-so</u> is <u>Yours</u>:
 The world and all its fullness, <u>You have</u> founded them.
- 12 The north and the south, You <u>have cre</u>-ated <u>them;</u> Tabor and Hermon re-joice <u>in</u> Your <u>name</u>.
- 13 You <u>have a mighty arm;</u>

Strong is Your hand, and high <u>is Your right hand</u>. 14 Righteousness and justice are the foun-<u>da-tion</u> of Your throne;

Mercy and truth go be-fore Your face.

- 15 Blessed are the people who <u>know the joyful sound!</u>
 They walk, O Lord, in the light <u>of Your counte-nance</u>.
- 16 In Your name they re-joice <u>all</u> day <u>long</u>, And in Your righteousness they are ex-alt-ed.
- 17 For You are the <u>glo-ry</u> of their <u>strength</u>, And in Your favor our horn <u>is ex-alt-ed</u>.
- 18 For our shield be-<u>longs to</u> the <u>Lord</u>, And our king to the Holy <u>One of Isra-el</u>.

Glory be to the <u>Fa-ther</u> and to the <u>Son</u>, And to the <u>Ho-ly</u> Spir-<u>it</u>.

I have declared Your righteousness and <u>Your sal-va-tion</u>:

I have not kept back Your loving <u>mer-cy</u> and Your truth.

19 Then You spoke in a vision to Your holy one, And said: "I have given help to one who is mighty; I have exalted one chosen from the peo-ple.

20 I have found My ser-vant Da-vid;

With My holy oil I have a-nointed him,

21 With whom My hand shall <u>be es</u>-tab-<u>lished</u>;

Also My arm shall strengthen him.

22 The enemy shall <u>not out</u>-wit <u>him</u>, Nor the son of wicked-<u>ness af</u>-flict <u>him</u>.

23 I will beat down his <u>foes</u> <u>be</u>-fore his <u>face</u>, And plague <u>those</u> who hate <u>him</u>.

24 "But My faithfulness and My mercy shall be with him, And in My name his horn shall be ex-alt-ed.

25 Also I will set his hand <u>o-ver</u> the <u>sea</u>,

And his right hand o-ver the riv-ers,

26 He shall cry to Me, 'You <u>are my</u> Fa-<u>ther</u>, My God, and the rock of <u>my sal</u>-va-<u>tion</u>.'

27 Also I will make him My first-born,

The highest of the <u>kings</u> of the <u>earth</u>.

28 My mercy I will keep for him for-ev-er,

And My covenant shall stand firm with him.

29 His seed also I will make to en-<u>dure for-ev-er</u>,

And his throne as the <u>days</u> of heav-en.

30 "If his sons for-sake My law

And do not walk in My judg-ments,

31 If they <u>break My</u> stat-<u>utes</u>
And do not keep <u>My com</u>-mand-<u>ments</u>,

32 Then I will punish their trans-gres-sion with the rod, And their in-i-qui-ty with stripes.

33 Nevertheless My lovingkindness I will not utterly <u>take</u> from him,

Nor allow My faith-ful-ness to fail.

34 My covenant I will not break,

Nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips.

35 Once I have sworn by My holi-ness;

I will not <u>lie to</u> Da-<u>vid</u>:

36 His seed shall en-dure for-ev-er,

And his throne as the sun be-fore Me;

37 It shall be established for-<u>ev-er</u> like the <u>moon</u>, Even like the faithful wit-ness in the sky."

Glory be to the <u>Fa-ther</u> and to the <u>Son</u>, And to the Ho-ly Spir-it.

And to the <u>Ho-iy</u> Spir-<u>it</u>.

- 45 The days of his youth <u>You have</u> short-<u>ened</u>; You have <u>cov-ered</u> him with <u>shame</u>.
- 46 How long, Lord? Will You hide Your-<u>self for-ev-er?</u> Will Your <u>wrath burn like fire?</u>
- 47 Remember how short my time is;
 For what futility have You created all the chil-dren of men?
- 48 What man can <u>live and</u> not see <u>death</u>?

 Can he deliver his life from the <u>pow-er</u> of the <u>grave</u>?
- 49 Lord, where are Your former <u>lov-ing-kindness-es</u>, Which You swore to Da-vid in Your truth?
- 50 Remember, Lord, the reproach of <u>Your ser-vants</u>—
 How I bear in my bosom the reproach of all the <u>man-y</u> peo-<u>ples</u>,
- 51 With which Your enemies <u>have re-proached</u>, O <u>Lord</u>, With which they have reproached the footsteps of <u>Your a-noint-ed</u>.
- 52 Blessed be the <u>Lord for</u>-ever-<u>more</u>! A-men and A-men.
