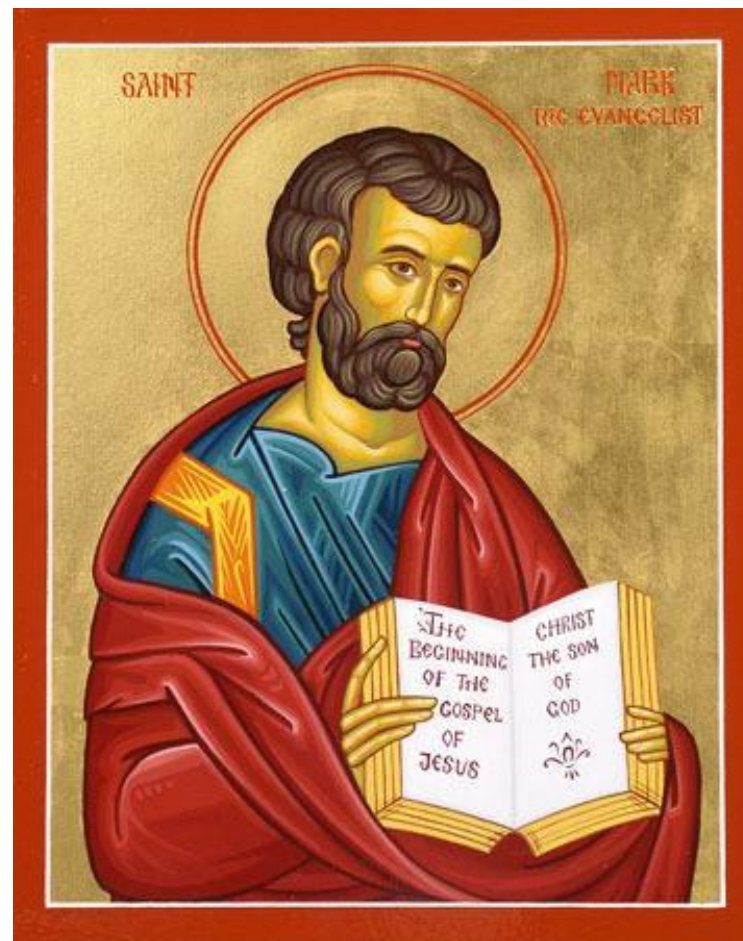

there-fore God has blessed You for-ev-er and ev-er.

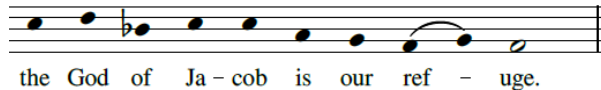
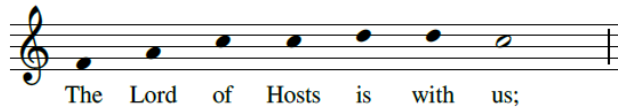


- 1 My heart is overflowing with a good theme; I recite my composition con-cern-ing the King; My tongue is the pen of a read-y writ-er.

*Benedicite, omnia opera*



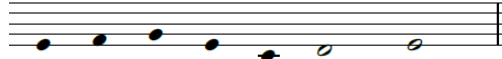
- 8 All Your garments are scented with myrrh and al-oes and
