

Glory be to the Fa-ther and to the Son,


And to the Ho-ly Spir-it.

At the voice of Your thunder they <u>has-tened</u> a-<u>way</u>.


8 They went up o-ver the moun-tains;

The cedars of Lebanon which He plant-ed,


17 Where the birds make their nests;

And seek their food from God.


22 When the sun rises, they gath-<u>er</u> to-geth-<u>er</u>

Is now, and will be for-ev-er. A-men.


