The Light of the Gospel

General Prayer of the Church

This morning we will be using the third prayer for "Pentecost" prayer from The Lutheran Liturgy(p.359-360).

ALMIGHTY GOD, who on the Day of Pentecost didst miraculously pour out Thy Spirit on the sons of men, we praise Thee for the gracious assurance that He shall remain with Thy people always, even unto the end of days. Without His mighty working we can do nothing that is pleasing unto Thee. We know not what to pray for as we ought, unless He help our infirmities and make intercession for us. No man can say that Jesus is Lord but by the Holy Ghost. We need His inspiration to think those things that are good and require His guidance to perform the same. Let not our past abuse of Thy mercies provoke Thee to cast us away from Thy presence and to take Thy Holy Spirit from us, but rather do Thou give us true repentance, and quicken us to greater diligence in the use of the means of grace and salvation.

Pour out Thy Spirit upon all flesh. Arise in the greatness of Thy strength, and awaken to a life of righteousness those who are dead in trespasses and sins. Send out Thy light and Thy truth to the nations that know not Thy name. Shed abroad all spiritual blessings on the churches of Thy saints. May they be edified by the truth as it is in Christ Jesus; and, walking in Thy fear and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, may they be multiplied exceedingly. Bless all the ministers of Thy Word; endue them with Thy Holy Spirit, enrich them with Thy heavenly grace, and let the words which they speak in Thy name be applied to the hearts of men in demonstration of the same Spirit and of power. Remember the righteous in their afflictions, help us in every time of need, and at the last grant us Thine everlasting peace, through Jesus Christ, our Lord.
