Communion

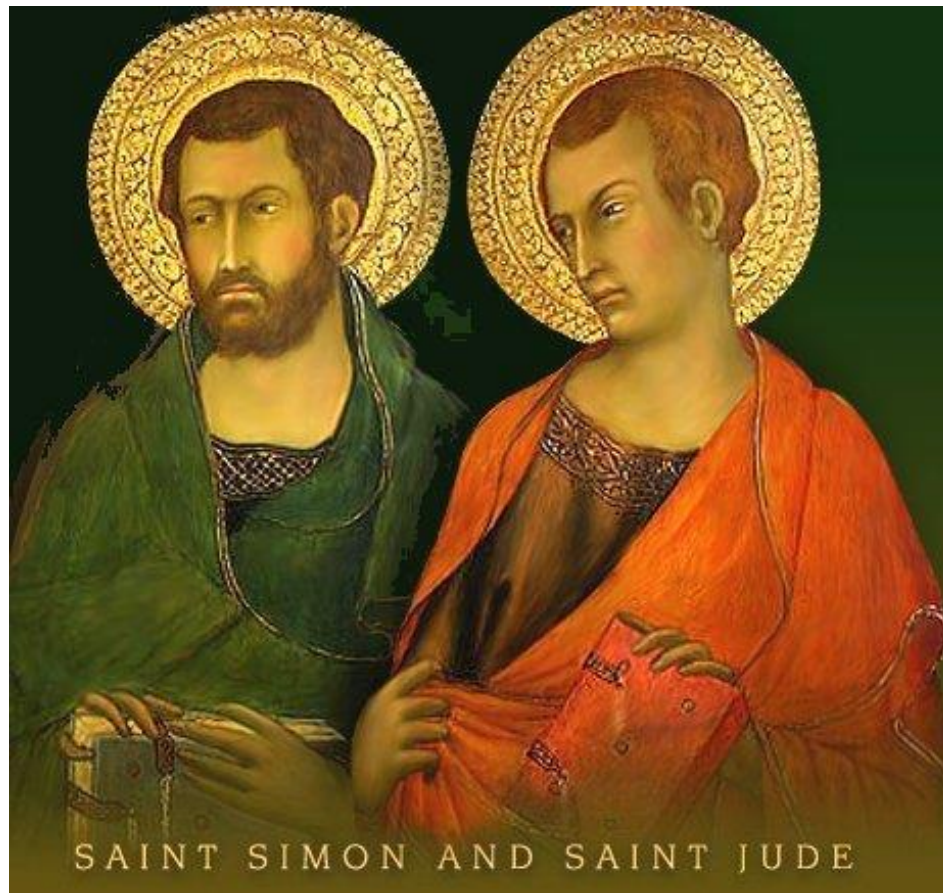
Jesus said to them, "Truly, I / say to you,
