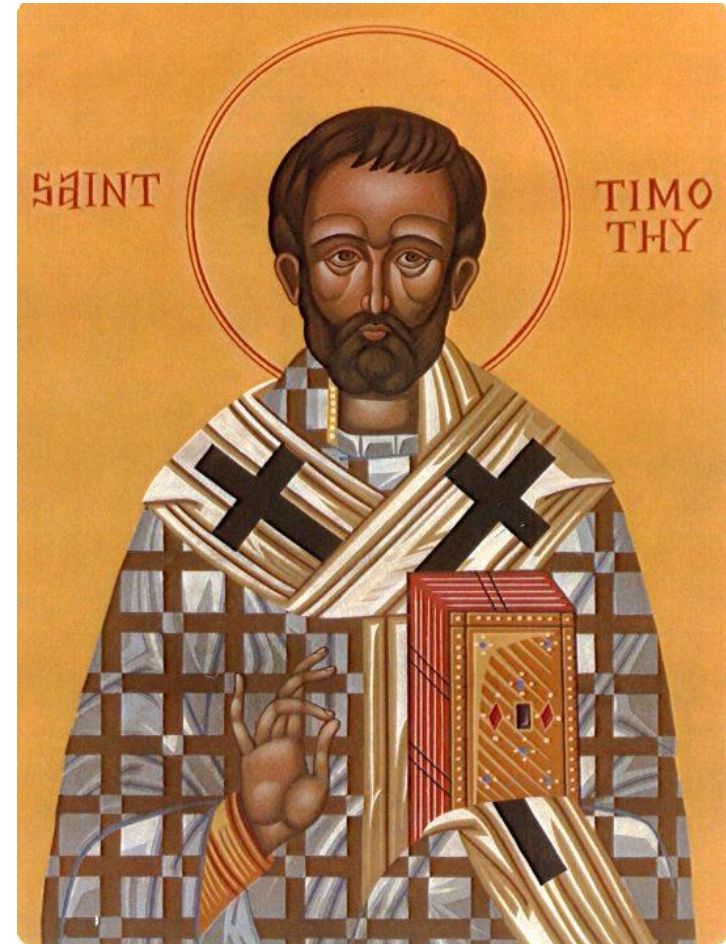
Communion
