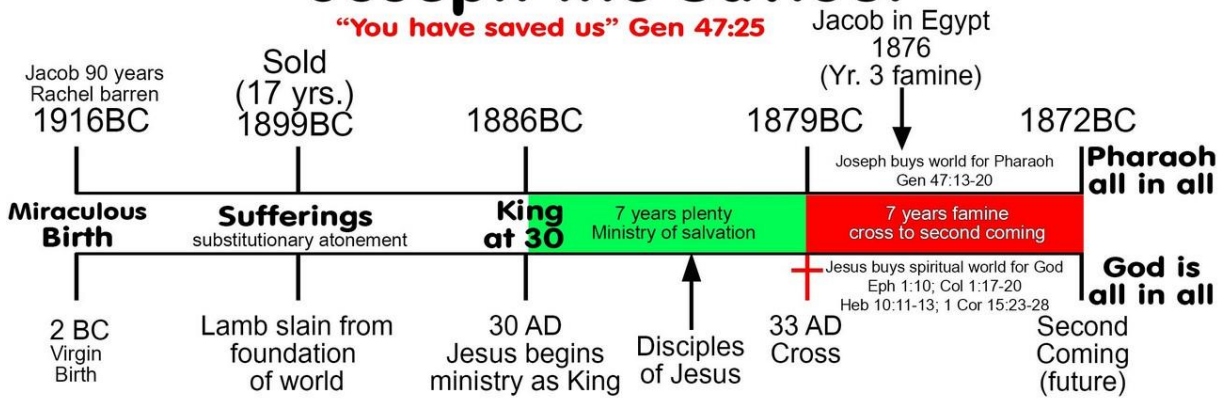

Biblical Types

A "Type" is some "person," "event," or "ceremony" that is recorded to "foreshadow" some future "person," "event," or "ceremony." For illustration.

- 1 TYPICAL PERSONS**, like Adam, Cain, Abel, Melchizedek, Abraham, Isaac, Joseph, Moses, Joshua, David, Jonah.
- 2 TYPICAL EVENTS**, like the "Flood," the "Sodom & Gomorrah," the "Passover," the "Brazen Serpent," "Crossing the Jordan," "Crossing the Red Sea."
- 3 TYPICAL CEREMONIES**, like the "Offerings," "The Passover," "Sabbath Day," "Year of Jubilee," "Day of Atonement."
