- The Gospel promise may not be sincere so your trust/faith in it may not save.
- The person seeks the secret knowledge of God if elected, then promise to save you is good if not elected...

Total depravity  
Unconditional Election  
Limited Atonement  
Irresistible Grace  
Perseverance of the saints

ARMINIAN - "Faith" → "Election"

The gospel promise is sincere, but it all depends upon you (decision, action)  
Did I do it? Have I fallen?

Free will  
Not a real election

LUTHERAN - Election → Faith (which saves)

God wants all to be saved. I can't save myself (dead in sins)  
Therefore, God works through Word/Sacrament -- always sincere  
He works repentance by the Law, He gives faith by the gospel promise  
All who believe are saved.

If I believe, then All thanks be to God -- it is all His work.  
When the believer wonders whether they will persevere...

God's Election (indirect proof) assures them.

It was God's plan before time to save you.

He chose you in Christ and will bring it to completion  
through faith in Christ.

Continue with His Word and Sacrament with faith in Christ.

When there is no faith, we point them to Law and Gospel promise  
to create faith.

The Lutheran Fathers (post Book of Concord)  
used Intuitu Fidei

→ Against the Calvinist  
God doesn't elect blindly.  
His election (before time)  
is seen (in time) through  
The instrument of faith.

C.F.W. Walther

refused to use Intuitu Fidei

→ Against the Arminian  
(man's work caused salvation)

Walther: God doesn't look ahead and see  
man's work (of faith) and then  
elect those based on it.

Walther: Election causes faith
