

Sabbath Exodus 20:8-11

Creation - God created the world in 6 days - Gen 2:2-3
and rested on the 7th day. (Saturday)
Rest Day = Sabbath

- No work for the purpose of
Lev 23:3 "a holy convocation"

3rd Commandment

Do Not	Do
despise - Preaching - His Word	- hold it (Preaching, Word) sacred - gladly hear and learn it.

31. All ceremonial laws have been abolished.
We are no longer required to keep the Sabbath (Saturday)

Jesus fulfilled the Sabbath rest.

Mark 2:27-28 Sabbath is made for man,
not man for the Sabbath

The Son of Man is Lord of the
Sabbath

Colossians 2:16-17

Therefore let no one judge you in food or in drink, or regarding a festival or a new moon or sabbaths, which are a shadow of things to come, but the substance is of Christ.



Hebrews 4:9-10 There remains then a Sabbath-rest for the people of God; for anyone who enters God's rest also rests from his own work, just as God did from his.

Pray Twice

Prayers

- 1) Reading/Hearing of God's Word
learn
- 2) Chanting/Singing of Psalms, Hymns, Songs
 - profess your faith
 - proclaim to others
- 3) Collects (Speaking to God)
to ask

Apology XV 38-42

The children chant psalms in order to learn,
the people sing, too, in order to learn or to worship."

True prayer

- faith relies on God (presented in His Word)
- words asking God to give us
what He says we need

Augsburg Confession V

The Office of the Ministry

To obtain such faith God instituted the office of the ministry, ← Pastoral Office that is provided the Gospel and the sacraments. Through these, as through means, He gives the Holy Spirit, who works faith, when and where He pleases, in those who hear the Gospel.
