## Original Sin

- 1) Concupiscence - inclination to do evil
  - 2) without the power to fear, love, and trust in God
- [lack of original righteousness]

Faith in Christ

## Justification (declared Righteous)

- Man receives Forgiveness of sins
- By grace
  - Through faith
  - for Christ's sake
  - apart from works

- Without Gospel
- no forgiveness
  - no faith
  - no grace
  - no righteousness

Main Doctrine  
Gospel-Promise of Justification

It gives all glory and honor to Christ and consolation to pious consciences.

### Effect:

- 1) New inclination of the heart to fear, love, trust in God
- 2) Begin to
  - Love God
  - Love Neighbor



67 Our opponents seek forgiveness of sins and justification by the Law. Human reason understands the law, as the Law is written on the mind. But reason only understands the external works, not faith, love, trust, etc.

## TWO KINDS OF RIGHTEOUSNESS

1) Civil Righteousness of the law produces civil works  
Pharisaic Righteousness external works  
Philosophical Right... of reason works of reason

This works righteousness does not save, because it only requires external works (2nd Table) and not also the 1st Table (Fear, Love, Trust). \* See Chart

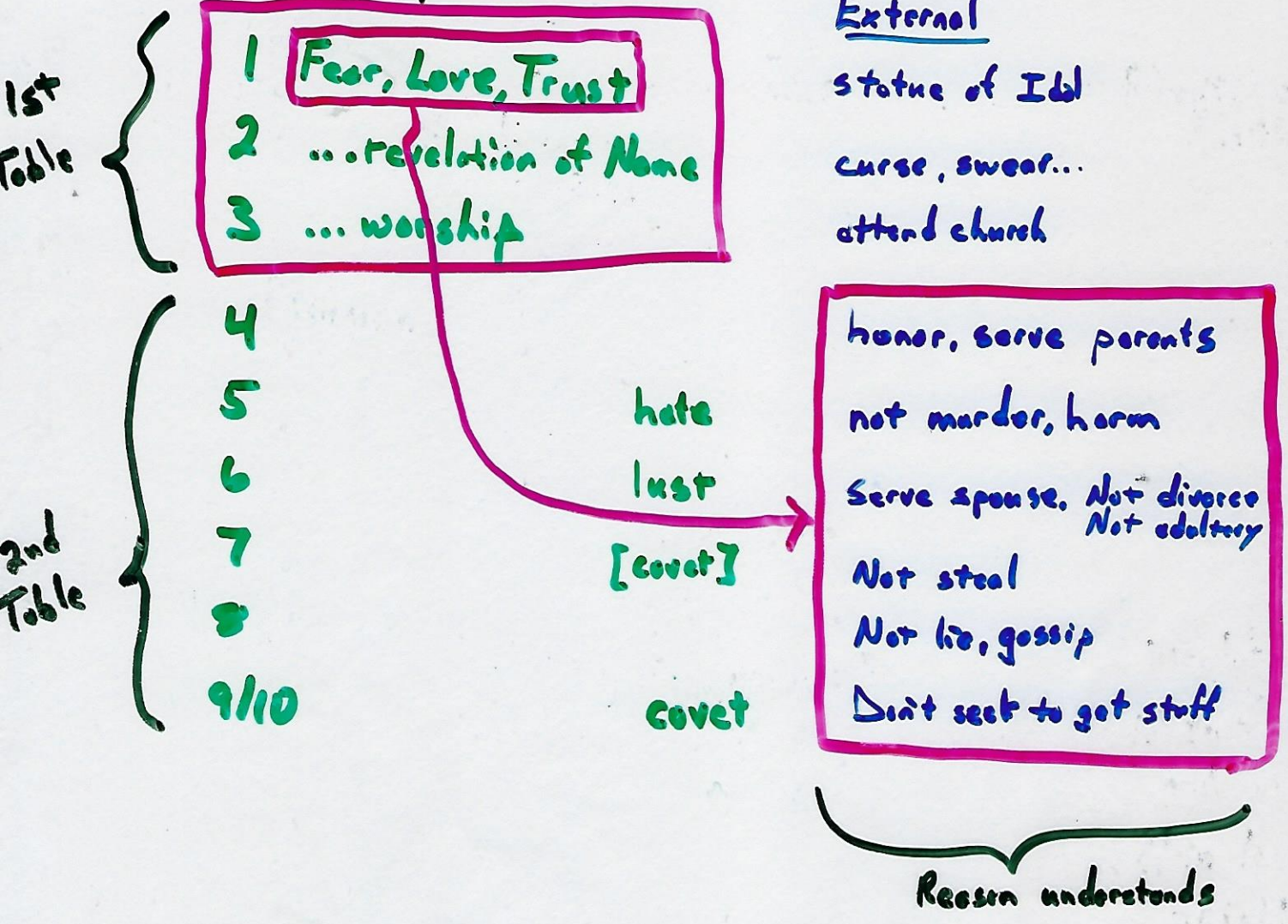
- righteousness by doing right things
- righteousness by love

- righteousness NOT by faith alone.

- Contempt for Christ's work
- vain trust in works
- creates despair and doubt

2) Christian Righteousness of faith produces true  
of the Gospel Fear  
Love  
Hope  
Confidence

This righteousness saves.

Matthew 22:37-40 'You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets.



Romans 13:10 Love does no harm to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfillment of the law.
