

42 What does such baptizing with water indicate?

It indicates that the Old Adam in us should by daily contrition and repentance be drowned and die with all sins and evil desires and that a new man should daily emerge and arise to live before God in righteousness and purity forever.

Where is this written?

St. Paul writes in Romans chapter six:

We were therefore buried with Him through baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father we too may live a new life.

(Rom 6:4)

Old Adam

Ps 51:5 I was sinful at birth, sinful from the time my mother conceived me.

Romans 5:12 Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all men, because all sinned...

v.15 ... for if the many died by the trespass of the one man...

v.19 For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of the one man, the many will be made righteous.

Eph 2:3 Like the rest by nature, objects of wrath

Eph 2:1 As for you, you were dead in your transgressions and sins...


New Man (One man = Jesus Christ.)

Romans 5:15 ... how much more did God's grace
and the gift that came by the grace of the
one man, Jesus Christ, overflow to the
many!

... but the gift followed many trespasses
and brought justification. For... how much
more will those who receive God's abundant
provision of grace and of the gift of righteousness
reign in life through the one man, Jesus Christ.

... so also through the obedience of the one
man the many will be made righteous.

... so also grace might reign through
righteousness to bring eternal life, through
Jesus Christ our Lord.

Romans 6:1 -

- v.1 We died to sin; how can we live in it any longer? ... -we don't respond to sinful desires
- v.3 Don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death?
- v.4 We were therefore buried with Him through baptism into death in order that just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.
- v.5 If we have been united with him in his death, we will certainly also be united with him in His resurrection.



For we know that our old self was crucified with Him so that the body of sin might be rendered powerless, that we should no longer be slaves to sin - because anyone who has died has been freed from sin.

Death to Sin

v.11 In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus.



Resurrection to New Life

v.13 Do not offer the parts of your body to sin,
 as instruments of wickedness,
 but rather offer yourselves to God, as
 those who have been brought from death
 to life; and offer the parts of your body
to Him as instruments of righteousness.

v.14 For sin shall not be your master, because
 you are not under law, but under grace.

v.15 You have been set free from sin
 and have become slaves to righteousness.

v.20 When you were slaves to sin...

v.22 ... set from sin and have become slaves to God ... leads to holiness and the result
 is eternal life.

Romans 7

v.6 But now, by dying to what once bound us,
 we have been released from the law,
 so that we serve in the new way of the Spirit,
 and not in the old way of the written code.

v.21 So I find this law at work:

When I want to do good
evil is right there with me.

For in my inner being I delight in God's Law;
 but I see another law at work in the members
 of my body, waging war against the law of
my mind and making me a prisoner of the law
 of sin at work within my members

Rom 12:1-2 renewing of your mind

v.24 What a wretched man I am!

Who will rescue me from this body
of death?

v.25 Thanks be to God - through Jesus Christ
our Lord!

So then I myself in my mind

am a slave to God's law,

but in the sinful nature a slave
to the law of sin.

Romans 8

v.3 For what the law was powerless to do, in
that it was weakened by the sinful nature,
God did by sending His Son...

v.9 You, however, are not controlled by
the sinful nature,
but by the Spirit, if the Spirit of God
lives in you...

v.10 But if Christ is in you,
your body is dead because of sin,
yet your Spirit is alive, because of righteousness

v.13 For if you live according to the sinful nature
you will die;
but if by the Spirit you put to death
the misdeeds of the body, you will live.

Be drowned and die

Put to death

Rom 8:13 put to death misdeeds of the body

Col 5:24 ... have crucified the sinful nature
with its passions and desires

Col 3:5 Put to death, therefore whatever
belongs to your earthly nature: ...

Ephesians 4:17

So I tell you this, and insist on it in the
Lord, that you must no longer live as the Gentiles
do, in the futility of their thinking.

18 They are darkened in their understanding...

19 Having lost all sensitivity, they ^{have} given
themselves over... (to sin)

WORD < Law — Shows our sin, old men
 Gospel — Forgiveness in Jesus, new life in Jesus

You were taught...

- with regard to your former way of life,

to put off your old self

which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires.

- to be made new in the attitude of your minds

and to put on the new self,

created to be like God in true righteousness and purity forever.

Ephesians 4

25 Therefore each of you must
- put off falsehood
- and speak truthfully to his neighbor,
for we are all members of one body.

1 John 1:8-10

If we claim to be without sin, we
deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us.

If ^① we confess our sins, he is faithful and
just and ^② will forgive us our sins
and purify us from all unrighteousness.
New Life

Daily

① Contrition - sorrow over sins

1 Jn 1:8-10 confess our sins

Eph 4:22 put off your old self

Mt 6:12 Forgive us our trespasses

James 5:16 Confess your sins to each other

② Repentance - (sorrow over sins) + Faith in Gospel

1 Jn 1:8-10 He is faithful and will forgive

Eph 4:24 Put on the new self

Jn 20:23 If you forgive anyone his sins,
they are forgiven.

New Life (Good Works follow repentance)

2 Cor 5:17 Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation;
the old has gone, the new has come!
