Exodus 11: 4-8, 9-10

Before Moses left (10:29), he told of 10<sup>th</sup> Plague

- first born die I will go out

- not Israelites, distinction

- left in hot anger

v.9 hardened

Exodus 12: 1-14

New Beginning - First Month

Abib, later Nisan

(what we call April)

"A birth" of God's people

Lamb - determines families to gather

- without blemish

- male

- a year old

- keep for 4 days

- kill at twilight (night before Passover)

v7-14

blood around door →

roasted (head, leg)

unleavened bread

bitter herbs

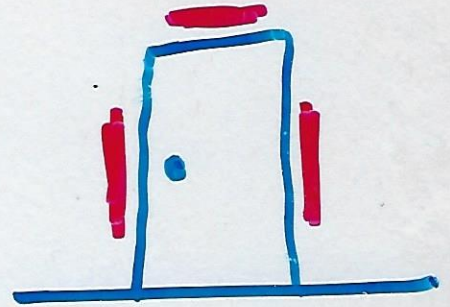
none is left

belt, sandals, staff

Lord's Passover → I will pass  
judgment

blood → "sign"

Feast, memorial, repeated

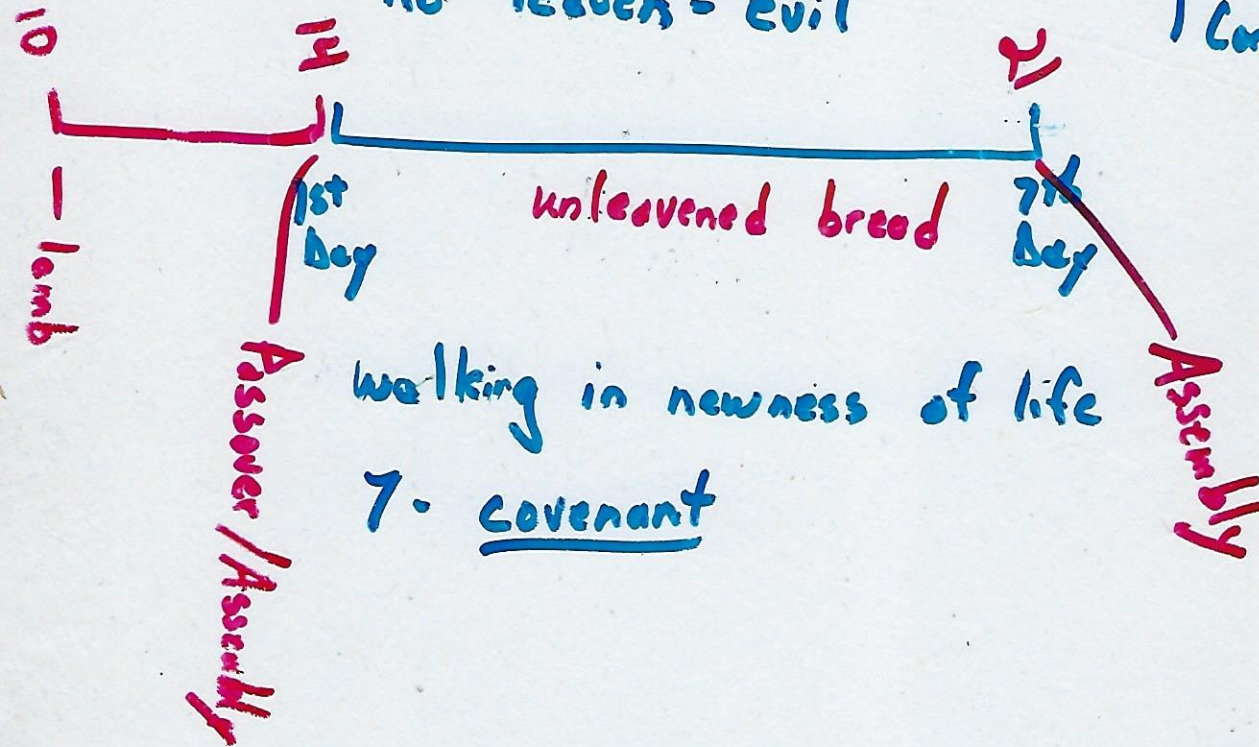


v. 15-20

Seven day feast of Mazzoth  
(unleavened bread)

life (bread), new pure life  
no leaven - evil

1 Cor 5:8

hyssop to apply blood (Lev 14:51, Num 19:18)  
purification

safety inside door

explore to your sons

12:29 - 32 - 36

Pharaoh says "Go!"

33 - Egyptians said "Hurry"  
took bread before it had risen (unleavened)  
gold, silver

37 - Ramses to Succoth to Etham & Hachiroth  
430 years  
night of watching  
(preservation night)  
over Red Sea
