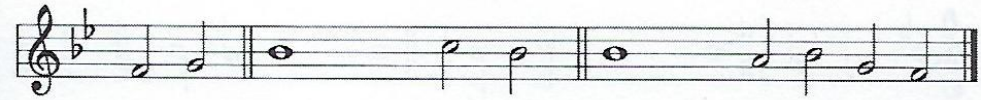
## 2 Corinthians 1:3-7
