4"Therefore it shall be, when you have crossed over the Jordan, that **on Mount Ebal** you shall set up **these stones**, which I command you today, and you shall whitewash them with lime. 5"And there you shall build **an altar** to the Lord your God, an altar of stones; you shall not use an iron tool on them. 6"You shall build with whole stones the altar of the Lord your God, and offer burnt offerings on it to the Lord your God. 7"You shall offer peace offerings, and shall eat there, and rejoice before the Lord your God. 8"And you shall write **very plainly** on the stones all the words of this law."

9Then Moses and the priests, the Levites, spoke to all Israel, saying, "Take heed and listen, O Israel: This day you have become the people of the Lord your God. 10"Therefore you shall obey the voice of the Lord your God, and observe His commandments(מְצִוֹתֵו) and His statutes(זְיִנוֹתִי) which I command

Chapter 29

1These are the words of the covenant which the Lord commanded Moses to make with the children of Israel in the land of Moab, besides the covenant which He made with them in Horeb.

2 Now Moses called all Israel and said to them:

"You have seen all that the Lord did before your eyes in the land of Egypt, to Pharaoh and to all his servants and to all his land—3"the great trials which your eyes have seen, the signs, and those great wonders. 4"Yet the Lord has not given you a heart to perceive and eyes to see and ears to hear, to this very day. 5"And I have led you forty years in the wilderness. Your clothes have not worn out on you, and your sandals have not worn out on your feet. 6"You have not eaten bread, nor have you drunk wine or similar drink, that you may know that I am the Lord your God.

7"And when you came to this place, Sihon king of Heshbon and Og king of Bashan came out against us to battle, and we conquered them. 8"We took their land and gave it as an inheritance to the Reubenites, to the Gadites, and to half the tribe of Manasseh. 9"Therefore keep the words of this covenant, and do them, that you may prosper in all that you do.

10"All of you stand today before the Lord your God: your leaders and your tribes and your elders and your officers, all the men of Israel, 11"your little ones and your wives—also the stranger who is in your camp, from the one who cuts your wood to the one who draws your water—12"that you may enter into covenant with the Lord your God, and into His oath, which the Lord your God makes with you today, 13"that He may establish you today as a people for Himself, and that He may be God to you, just as He has spoken to you, and just as He has sworn to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

14"I make this covenant and this oath, not with you alone, 15"but with him who stands here with us today before the Lord our God, as well as with him who is not here with us today

22"so that the coming generation of your children who rise up after you, and the foreigner who comes from a far land, would say, when they see the plagues of that land and the sicknesses which the Lord has laid on it: 23'The whole land is brimstone, salt, and burning; it is not sown, nor does it bear, nor does any grass grow there, like the overthrow of Sodom and Gomorrah, Admah, and Zeboim, which the Lord overthrew in His anger and His wrath.'

24"All nations would say, 'Why has the Lord done so to this land? What does the heat of this great anger mean?' 25"Then people would say: 'Because they have forsaken the covenant of the Lord God of their fathers, which He made with them when He brought them out of the land of Egypt; 26'for they went and served other gods and worshiped them, gods that they did not know and that He had not given to them. 27'Then the anger of the Lord was aroused against this land, to bring on it every curse that is written in this book. 28'And the Lord uprooted them from their land in anger, in wrath, and in great indignation, and cast them into another land, as it is this day.'

29"The secret things belong to the Lord our God, but those things which are revealed belong to us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law.
