

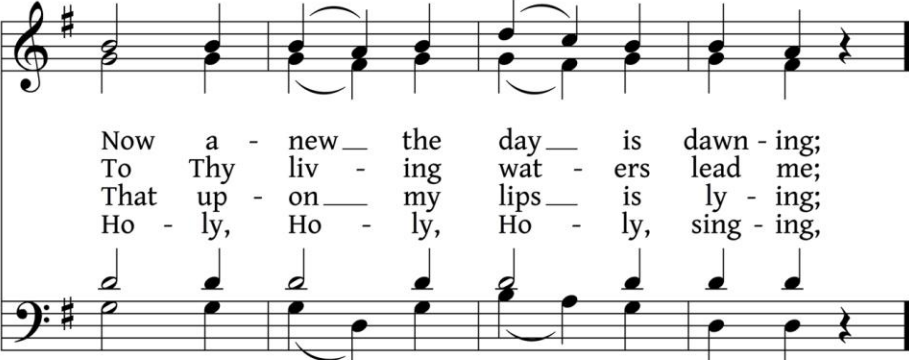

4. Let me with my heart to - day,



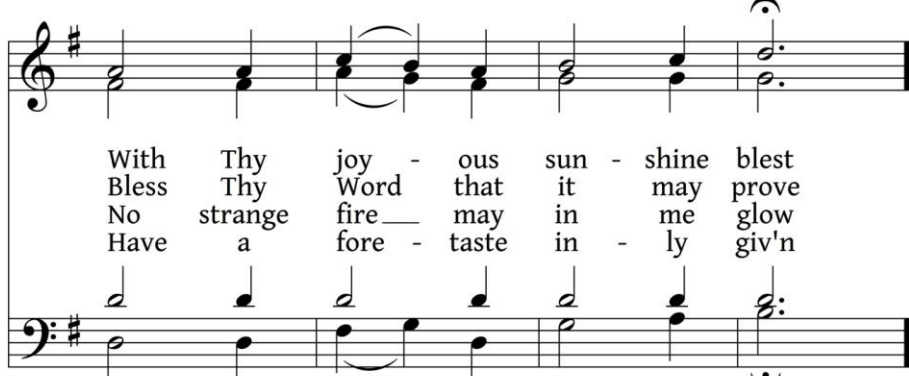
Now a - new the day is dawn - ing;
