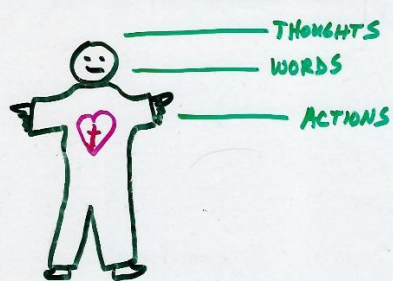
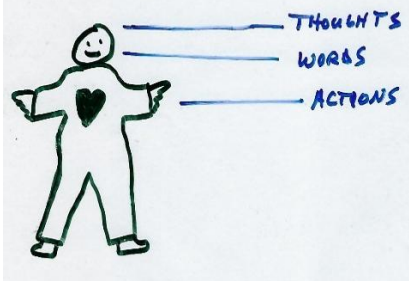
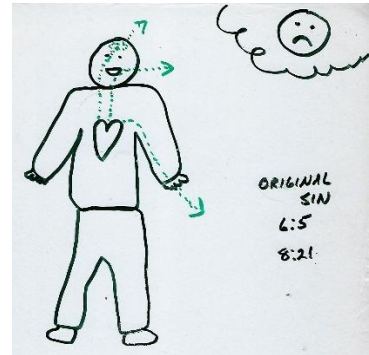
Lesson Six: Genesis 6-9

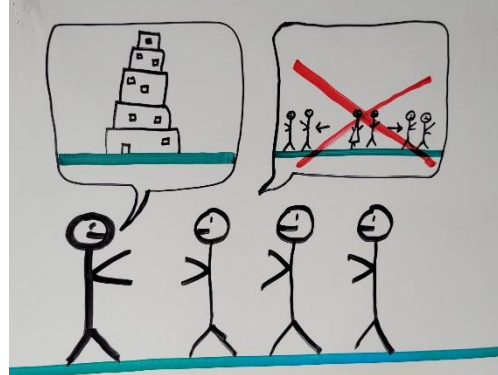
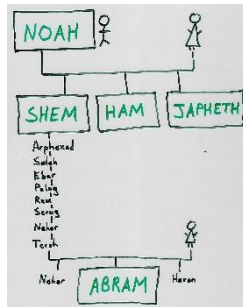


Lesson Seven: Genesis 10-11

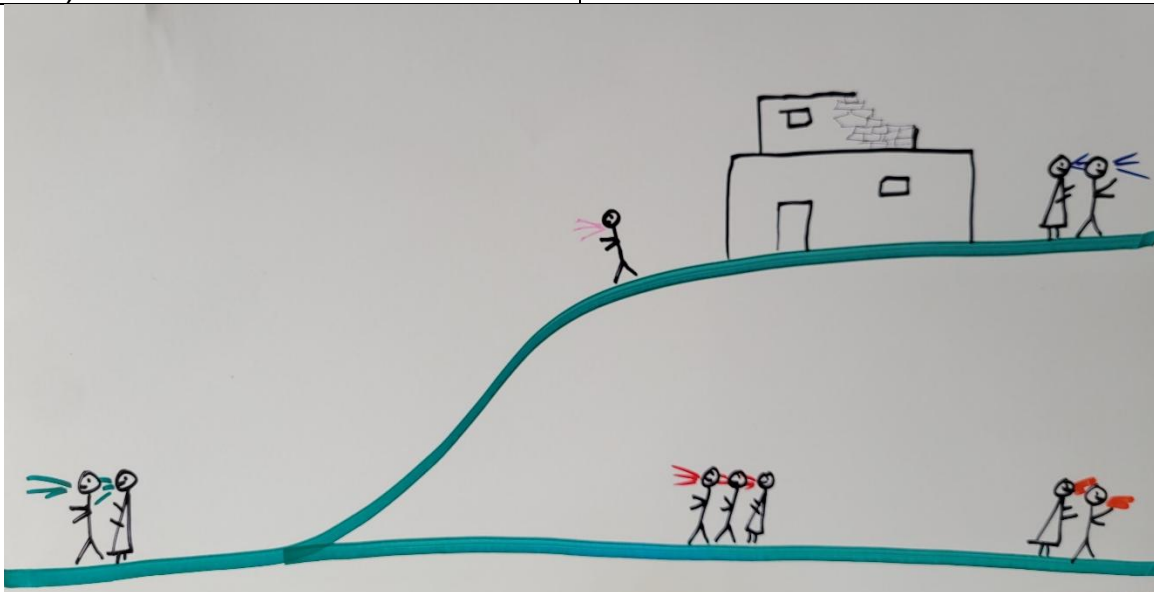
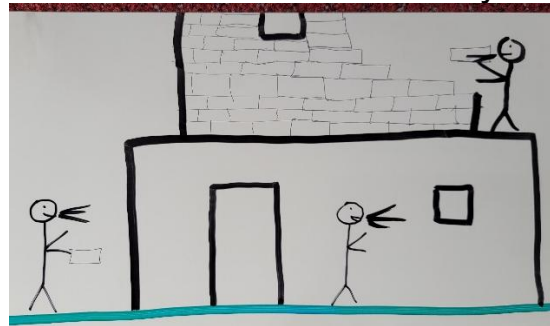
"Now the whole earth had one language and one speech."



1. "Be fruitful and increase in number and fill the earth..." (1:28, 9:1,7)
2. Trust in God = "Walked with God" (5:24, 6:9, Shem's descendants)
3. Call on the Name of the Lord (4:26)
4. The Promised Savior is the way back to paradise/heaven. (The male child defeats serpent 3:15)

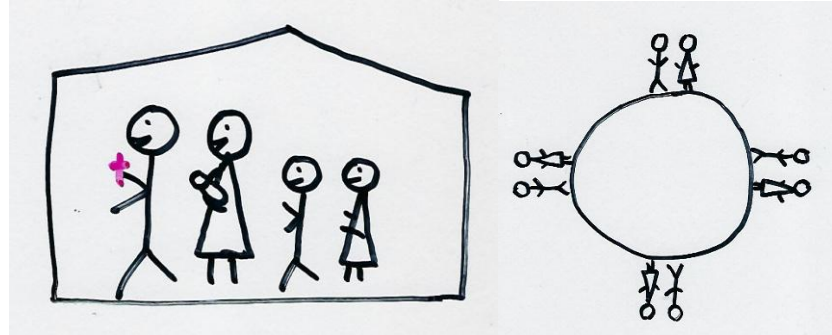


1. Not be scattered

4. Reached to heaven = Idolatry

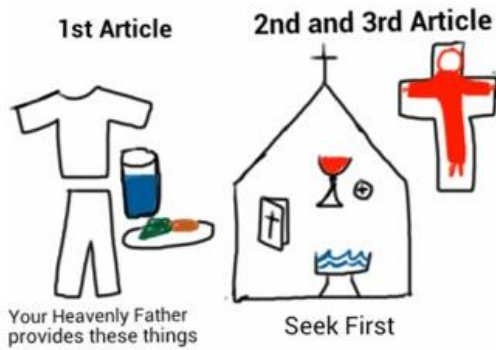

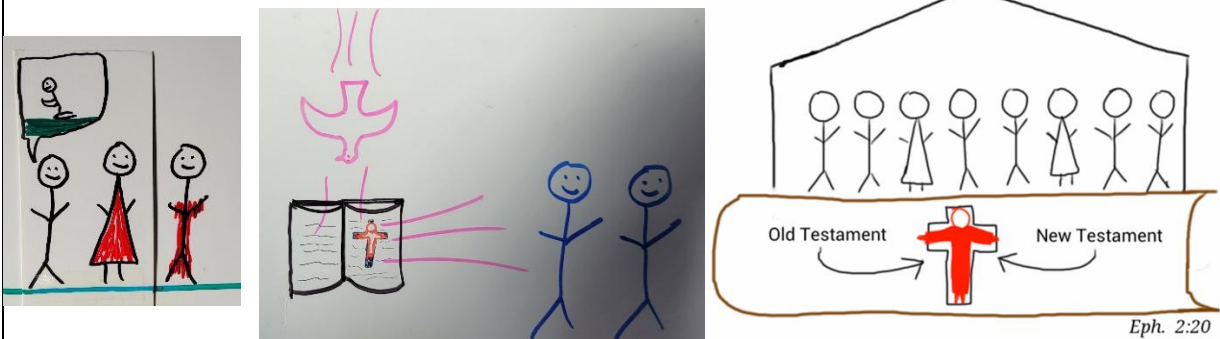
