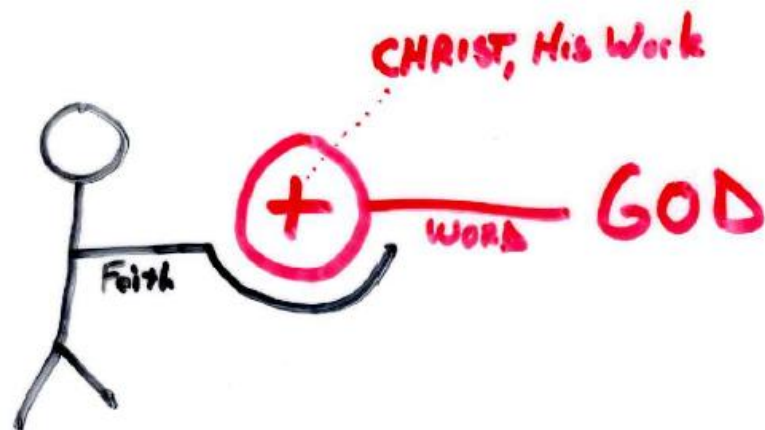

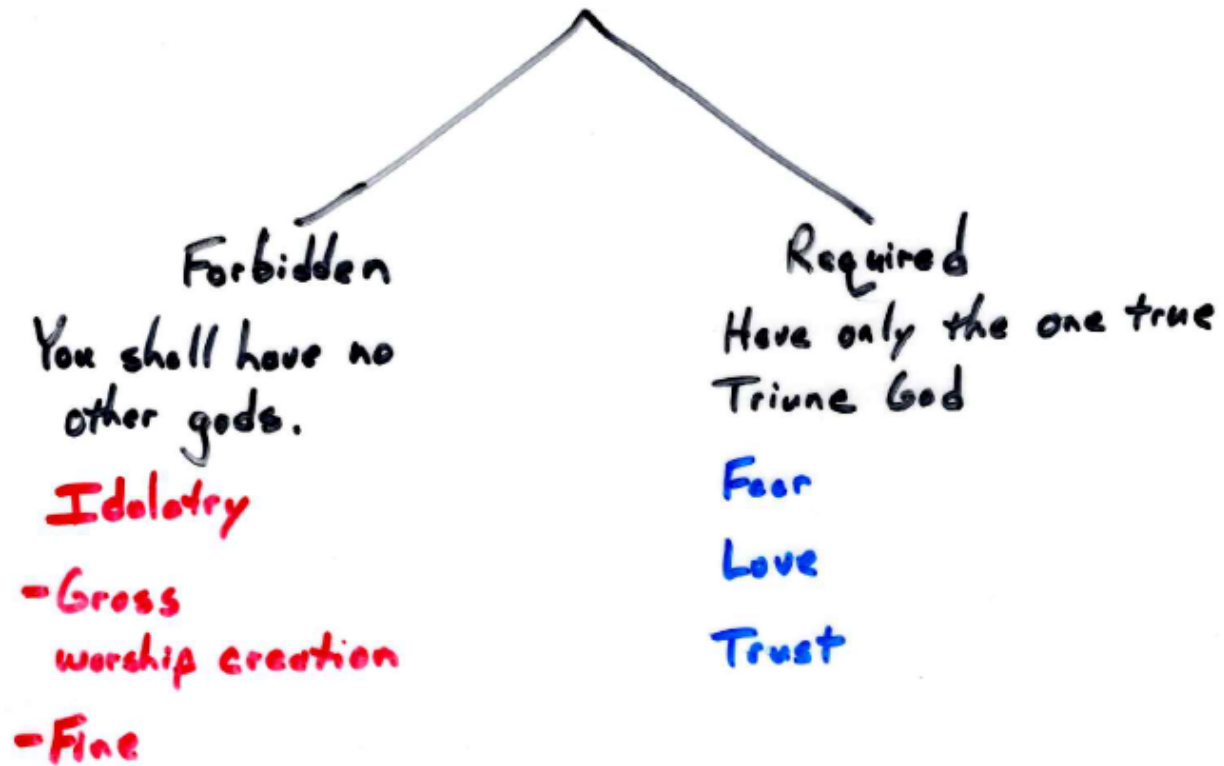
Belief, Faith, Trust

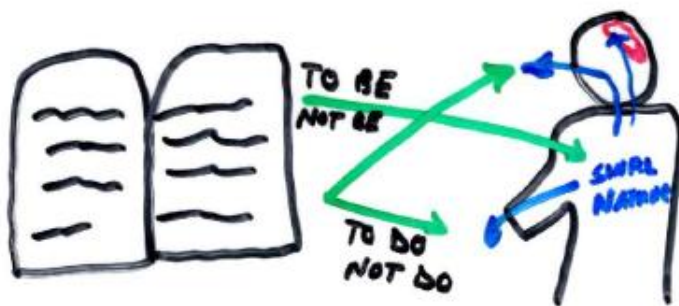
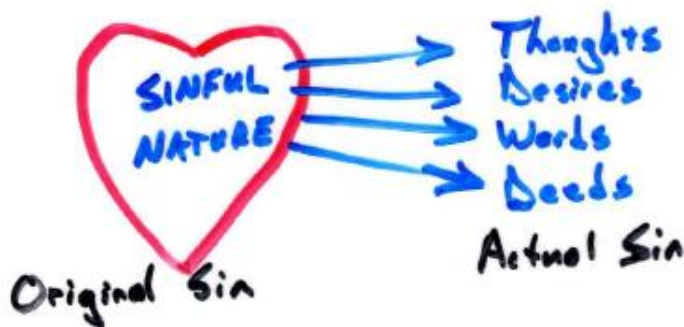

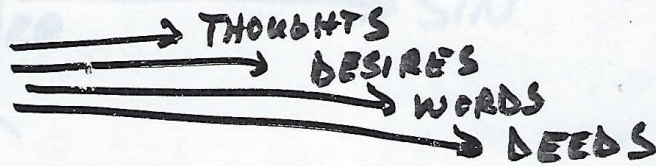
What is sin? **every departure from the Law.**
